Dr. Renault is an infectious diseases specialist who has treated patients at the Palo Alto Veterans Health Care System and has taught medical residents and infectious diseases fellows at Stanford and the Palo Alto VA for the past 14 years. Dr. Renault lost her father to acute leukemia at the age of 19, and her experience living through her father's illness has influenced her approach as she cares for patients, where she values showing empathy and vulnerability in her interactions with patients and their families. Dr. Renault will discuss how her personal experience living through her father's illness and passing introduced significant emotional challenges during her medical training, and how ultimately her experience allows her to connect with patients and their families on a meaningful level, not only as a physician, but as a person.
